IMPORTANT INFORMATION**

CAMPING/PARKING:

- Due to limited space you will be required to park in designated parking areas only.
- Primitive camping only. There is no charge for camping. Please do not roll out awnings etc.
- **NO PLAY RIDING IN THE CAMPGROUNDS!! This includes Rhinos, Golf Carts etc.** 5 MPH rule will be strictly enforced. Riders are responsible for their family and friends. Minors entering the campground must be accompanied by a parent/legal guardian. Disqualification could result from infractions
- Pit Transport vehicles will be required to have a permit which will be available at Sign Ins. No one under 16 years will be issued a permit. Passengers are limited to the number passengers the vehicle was originally designed to hold. Pit vehicles cannot be used 1 hour after the finish of the last race. Pit Vehicles are to be used for transport only and no play riding will be tolerated. **THESE RULES WILL BE STRICKLY ENFORCED!!**
- Absolutely **NO** Non Contestant riding allowed except to get to the start line/pit areas. 5 MPH rule enforced
- Please obey the parking staff at all times.
- No driving, riding, parking or washing bikes in or near the river. The campground is partially on BLM property. Please do your part in keeping the campground area clean. **Pack out all your garbage.**
- Dogs must remain on a leash at all times.
- No loud music or excessive noise after 10:00 p.m.

SIGN INS:

- Sign Ins will be open at 6:30 A.M. on Saturday for Saturday's races and will close ½ hour before the start of each race for that race. Sign Ins for Sunday's races will be open from 4:00 p.m. to 5:30 p.m. on Saturday and will open at 6:30 A.M. on Sunday. Sign Ins will close ½ hour before the start of each race for that race. Sign Ins for the Exhibition "King of Hearts" Night Challenge will be open on Saturday from 3:00-4:30 only.
- Please bring your AMA & District 36 cards and with you to sign ins. (AMA Cards and D-36 Cards are required to race and will be available to purchase at sign ins if you do not have one)
- Transponders are required for all riders and will be available to purchase at sign ins.
- Minors (under 18) Must have parent or guardian present at sign ins. **NO EXCEPTIONS**
- Saturday's entry fees are \$45.00. Sunday's entry fees are \$55.00. "AA" Class entry fee is \$75.00 (100% Payback!!)
- Gate fee is \$5.00 per person per day.

PITS:

- **NO Minors, Dogs, Smoking or Alcohol in the pits. NO EXCEPTIONS!!**
- Per D-36 Rules pit stops are dead engine and this will be strictly enforced.
- There will be only 4 pit crew members per rider allowed in the Pit area. Pit Crews: While in the pit area must stay behind the barriers at all times. Riders are responsible for their pit crews.
- There is a 5 mile per hour speed limit in the pit area.

TECH:

- Sound testing will be in effect. The sound limit of 96 dbs will be enforced.
- Your D-36 numbers with the correct color combination background needs to be on all three number plates.
- Green, Red Stickers or license plate required. Spark Arrestors required.

OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

- Be in your correct row on the starting line 15 minutes before your race for the Mandatory Riders Meeting.
- All riders must stop at home check. No passing, Stay single file from the yellow flag into the check.
- No Rider Medical Insurance
- Spectators witnessing these events thereby assume all risks for any injury or damages
- Spectators are not allowed on the course at any time.
- Finisher pins will be given after the checkered flag.
- Results and awards should be available 30 minutes after the last rider is in if there are no protests.
